Reba M. Wadsworth is a former elementary classroom teacher, guidance counselor and principal. She has served as an adjunct professor of literacy at three Alabama universities at both the graduate and undergraduate level. Reba has conducted workshop on literacy at the local, state, national and international level. She is currently working with a team of educators from both the states and Ethiopia to write a language arts program for the schools of Ethiopia. While a principal, Reba was named a District I National Distinguished Principal and the first Alabama Outstanding Principal of Reading by the Alabama Reading Association. During her tenure as principal, the school was named an Alabama Blue Ribbon School and was named an Exemplary School by the International Reading Association. She is the co-author of two recently published books by Heinemann: *Learning Under the Influence of Language and Literature* and *Reading Aloud Across the Curriculum* and is under contract for a third book using children's literature to support the writing workshop.
